



Student Impact Grant Guidelines

Purpose:

- To provide educators with small grants that enhance the learning environments and meet the specific needs of the students they serve. These grants offer financial support beyond what tax dollars and school budgets can provide.

Eligible Applicants:

- Applicants must support K-12 students in Lake Mills area schools.
- Educators can be any staff member who works directly with students on their learning and growth within the school environment.

Eligible Projects/Programs:

- Grants applications may be for equipment, materials, supplies, activities, or programs that support students' needs.
- Grants will not be provided for religious or sectarian purposes, unless such provides benefit to the community as a whole.
- Grant funding may not be used for lobbying, partisan political purposes or campaigns.
- Requests must have the approval of the school's principal. Requests from public school educators must also be approved by the school district's Director of Business Services.

Grant Amounts:

- The total amount available for awards each year will be determined by the LMACF Board of Directors.
- Individual grant awards will not exceed \$500.
- Grants will be paid to the school district to be used in the current fiscal year.
